




## **DEPARTMENT OF BIOTECHNOLOGY, KALINGA UNIVERSITY**

They visited HPMC Plant (H.P. Horticulture Produce Marketing & Processing Corporation) at Parwanoo, Chandigarh on 1 Feb 2018. The students met Mr. Brijmohan, General Manager and **Miss. Ankita, Production officer of HPMC plant.**

**Mr. Brijmohan** gave the best knowledge for the production of his fruit industry and details about govt. policy related to HPMC (H.P. Horticulture Produce Marketing & Processing Corporation (HP State Government Undertaking) popularly known as HPMC was incorporated on 10th June, 1974 with the financial assistance of World Bank. The mandate of this organization was to provide post-harvest facilities to the fruit growers of the state and to help them get the best returns for their produce from the market; **he assured that students can join them for their project and training purpose and he will help in recruitment of trained students in associated companies.**

Production officer Ms. Ankita had given the best knowledge related to juice processing like fruit storage and sterilization, pulp making, concentration and pH measurement, quality control, Biochemical testes, canning and packaging with marketing process. She briefed the students that the HPMC was established with the objective of marketing of fresh fruits juice and processing of all types of surplus fruits. Today, HPMC has graduated to include a wide range of high quality fruit juices, drinks, pulps, concentrates, squashes, fruit wines, ciders, jams, pickles and mineral water to its portfolio. HPMC has had the good fortune of sourcing its fruits directly from India's fruit bowl, Himachal Pradesh.

The location has a religious and Archaeological importance, so it was a nice experience for the students to see and learn more about Indian history. 
