These measures aim to standardize research practices, enhance scholarly output, and ensure adherence to the highest academic standards. These initiatives are as follows:

- **Provision of Research Support Materials**

Study guides on Research Methodology and Statistics have been prepared to assist Ph.D. scholars throughout their research.

- **Integration of External Examiner Feedback**

Comments from external thesis reviewers are recorded and shared with departments to enhance thesis quality and reduce negative evaluations.

- **Advance Thesis Submission for Supervisor Review**

Thesis submission before the pre-Ph.D. presentation allows supervisors to provide detailed feedback and recommend improvements.

- **Supervisor Certification of Thesis Review**

Supervisors must certify that they have thoroughly reviewed the thesis, ensuring better evaluation outcomes from external examiners.

- **Initial Plagiarism Report by Researcher**

Candidates submit a preliminary plagiarism report, allowing early detection and correction of content issues.

- **Final Plagiarism Verification by Library**

The Central Library conducts a final plagiarism check, with the report officially signed and stamped to confirm authenticity.
