Details of Program:

The event titled “World River Day” was organized on 24th September 2025 by the NCC Army Wing, Kalinga University, Naya Raipur (C.G.), under the initiative of “Puneet Sagar Abhiyan” as per the directions of HQ DG NCC. This activity was part of the Social Service and Community Development (SSCD) Calendar, for which Kalinga University was allotted to organize the World River Day Activity.

The program was held offline at Kalinga University, Kotni, Naya Raipur, from 02:00 PM onwards, with 37 cadets actively participating. The event aimed to create awareness about river conservation and cleanliness under the theme “#Hamari Nadiya – Hamari Zimmedari (Cleaning & Protecting Rivers – Cradle of Civilization & Lifeline)”.

Objective of Program:

The primary objective of celebrating World River Day was to promote awareness and understanding of river conservation, emphasizing their ecological, cultural, and economic importance. The program aimed to sensitize cadets toward issues of river pollution and encourage sustainable measures for preserving natural water resources.

Through creative poster-making and awareness activities, the event sought to:

- Instill a sense of responsibility among cadets toward protecting rivers and aquatic ecosystems.
- Educate students on the connection between river health and sustainable living.
- Encourage teamwork, innovation, and environmental stewardship through participatory learning.
- Align university-level initiatives with the broader national campaign Puneet Sagar Abhiyan and the global UN SDGs framework.
