MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is made on this **4th March 2025**, by and between:

Kalinga University, Kotni, Naya Raipur hereinafter referred to as 'KU', represented by its Registrar- Dr. Sandeep Gandhi, hereinafter referred to as 'First Party'.

AND

Positive Health Zone, located behind Regalia Complex, Raipur, Chhattisgarh, represented by Dr. Anil Kumar Gupta (MBBS, MS, Ph.D) Founder and Director of Positive Health Zone and Shri Ganesh Vinayak Eye Hospital, hereinafter referred to as 'Second Party'.

WHEREAS, Dr. Anil Kumar Gupta, M.B.B.S., M.S., Ph.D. (Director of Shri Ganesh Eye Hospital and Founder & Director of Positive Health Zone), is a Consultant Eye Surgeon and Holistic & Lifestyle Medicine Expert. With a specialized focus on Holistic Health and 7 Dimensional Wellness, he possesses expertise in Quantum Medicine and Bio-field Science. Dr. Gupta employs a personalized Mind-Brain-Body-Soul approach to identify and address the root causes of lifestyle and psychosomatic conditions. 1. Academic collaboration in Yoga and allied healthcare.
2. Training and skill development programs.
3. Placement opportunities for students at Kalinga University in relevant healthcare fields.
4. Health Services to the Staffs and Students.
5. To plan and organize various health awareness initiatives for the benefit of society, in collaboration and under a unified platform.
6. To engage students through conducting interviews and diagnosing mental health concerns; stress management; lifestyle issues.
7. To empower professionals currently in the field to advance their qualifications as Rehabilitation Psychologists and Clinical Psychologists, Vedic Science.

2. SCOPE OF COLLABORATION

Our potential collaboration could focus on the following areas:

- a. Joint workshops, Seminars and Training programs.
- b. Facilitating internships and placements.
- c. Providing practical training in healthcare practices.
- d. Mutual support in curriculum development.
- e. Sharing of academic study materials and additional pertinent information.
- f. To plan and organize various health awareness initiatives for the benefit of society, in Collaboration and under a unified platform.
- g. To educate and promote the Integrated Holistic Healthcare (IHH) approach to students and faculty for both personal and professional application.

3. ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

3.1 First Party (Kalinga University)

- a. Identify eligible students for training and placements.
- b. Coordinate events and provide infrastructure for academic programs.

3.2 Second Party (Positive Health Zone):

- a. Provide training programs for selected students.
- b. Offer internship and placement opportunities.
- c. Share expertise through workshops and seminars.
- d. Seminar to Raise Awareness on Eye Health and Various other Health Sectors.
- e. Organize Free of Cost Eye Camps and Health Camps for Staffs and Students.

4. CONFIDENTIALITY

This document contains confidential and proprietary information intended exclusively for the recipient. The contents herein may not be disclosed, reproduced, or distributed to any third party without the prior written consent of both the First Party and the Second Party.

By receiving this document, the recipient agrees to maintain the confidentiality of the information contained herein and to use it solely for its intended purpose. Any unauthorized use or disclosure is prohibited and may result in legal action.

For the purposes of this MOU, 'confidential information' does not include information that is already in the public domain, information that enters the public domain through no fault of the receiving party, or information that must be disclosed pursuant to applicable law or a court order.

5. DURATION

This MoU remains valid for three (3) years from the date of signing and can be renewed upon mutual agreement.

This Memorandum of Understanding will take effect from the date of signing of this MoU by both the parties herewith. It shall remain in force initially for a period of 3 years until terminated by either party on mutual agreement.

This MoU may be amended or extended by the mutual written consent of the parties. The two parties have the right to place their logos and seals on their certificates and cards.

6. TERMINATION

Either party may terminate this MoU by providing written notice to the other party at least three (3) months in advance. All obligations incurred prior to termination shall remain in full effect.

7. DISPUTE RESOLUTION

Disputes will be resolved through mutual discussion or, if unresolved, through an independent arbitrator appointed by mutual agreement.
