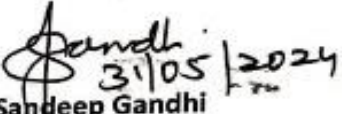

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Speech and Essay Writing Competition on International Day of Clean Air for Blue Skies 2024

On September 7, 2024, Kalinga University proudly hosted the International Day of Clean Air for Blue Skies. The event aimed to raise awareness about air pollution and promote environmental sustainability, attracting 117 participants from various educational institutions in Raipur, including Hidayatullah National Law University, Shri Rawatpura Sarkar University, Amity University, and Kalinga University.

Program Objectives

1. **Raise Awareness:** Educate participants about air pollution and its effects on health and the environment.
2. **Encourage Engagement:** Foster active participation in discussions and competitions on environmental sustainability.
3. **Promote Solutions:** Highlight technological advancements and strategies to mitigate air pollution.
4. **Inspire Commitment:** Encourage participants to take the LIFE Mission pledge for sustainable practices.
5. **Facilitate Networking:** Create a platform for collaboration and idea-sharing among students and professionals.



Inauguration

The event was inaugurated by **Dr. R. Shridhar**, Vice Chancellor of Kalinga University, who emphasized the urgent need to enhance efforts in controlling air pollution. His address set a positive tone for the day's activities.

Keynote Speakers

- **Dr. Anita Savant**, Senior Scientific Officer, CECB delivered an impactful talk focusing on air pollution in Chhattisgarh. She emphasized the significant challenges posed by air quality degradation, particularly due to mining activities in the region. She highlighted the detrimental effects of mining on air quality, noting that dust and emissions from these activities contribute to respiratory problems and other health issues in local communities. Dr. Savant also stressed the importance of individual actions in the fight against air pollution. She encouraged attendees to adopt small, daily practices that collectively contribute to cleaner air, such as using public transportation, reducing vehicle usage, supporting local green initiatives, and practicing energy conservation at home. Her talk served as a reminder that while systemic changes are essential, individual responsibility plays a crucial role in creating a healthier environment for future generations. Through awareness and small, actionable steps, everyone can contribute to the larger goal of improving air quality in Chhattisgarh and beyond.
- **Mr. R.K. Sharma**, Superintendent Engineer, CECB, provided a broad overview of the technological interventions industries are implementing to combat air pollution. He highlighted several cutting-edge technologies that have been adopted to reduce emissions, such as advanced filtration systems, dust suppression methods, and real-time air quality monitoring tools. In his presentation, Mr. Sharma discussed future strategies aimed at further improving air quality. He emphasized the need for industries to embrace innovative practices and sustainable technologies, fostering a culture of continuous improvement. This includes investing in research and development to find new solutions tailored to local challenges. He encouraged the younger generation to actively participate in efforts to reduce air pollution by making conscious changes in their daily lives—such as using eco-friendly transportation options, minimizing waste, and promoting clean energy sources. Furthermore, he advocated for cultivating a scientific temper among youth, urging them to think critically and creatively in addressing environmental issues. By encouraging curiosity and innovation, Mr. Sharma believes the next generation can lead the way in developing solutions that will have a lasting impact on air quality and overall environmental health.

Competitions

The event featured a Speech and Essay Writing Competition, showcasing the talent and commitment of the participants. A total of 57 national and international students actively engaged in the competitions, presenting thought-provoking speeches and insightful essays on the theme of clean air and environmental sustainability.

Awards

Participants were recognized for their outstanding contributions, with cash prizes awarded as follows:

- **First Prize:** Rs 2000
- **Second Prize:** Rs 1500
- **Third Prize:** Rs 1100
- **Three Consolation Prizes:** Rs 500 each



In the Essay Writing Competition, Garima Agrawal from the Department of Journalism and Mass Communication, Kalinga University achieved 1st place, followed by Dipti Jain from Amity University in 2nd, and Amit Adarsh, Department of Zoology, Kalinga University, securing 3rd place. Asna Jabi from Department of Law, Kalinga University and Faizu Abba Ungogo from Department of Botany received consolation prizes, reflecting the broad spectrum of disciplines represented. In the Speech Competition, Aman Raj from Hidayatullah National Law University, Naya Raipur claimed the top position, with Masood Ahmed from Department of Law, Kalinga University and Shantanu Patel from HNLU claiming the 2nd and 3rd positions respectively. Consolation prizes were awarded to Jasmine Parveen from Shri Rawatpura Sarkar University and Koklo Z. Davis from Kalinga University, further underscoring the diverse contributions from various institutions. Collectively, these competitions served to enrich the academic community through the sharing of varied perspectives and insights.

Total Participation – 117

The participation of students from various educational backgrounds was a standout feature of the event, enriching discussions with a wide array of perspectives. Many students shared heartfelt childhood memories of blue skies, evoking nostalgia, and a collective yearning for cleaner air. This emotional connection fueled their passionate calls for increased action against air pollution. Students from the journalism department highlighted the critical need for more robust dialogue surrounding climate change, stressing the importance of media engagement in raising public awareness and driving policy changes. Meanwhile, law students focused on various national and international legal frameworks designed to tackle the climate crisis, discussing how legislation can play a pivotal role in environmental protection. They also threw light on landmark Supreme Court verdicts related to air pollution, illustrating how judicial interventions have shaped policies and reinforced the need for stricter regulations. This diverse representation emphasized the multifaceted nature of the air quality issue and showcased a unified commitment among participants to advocate for cleaner air and a sustainable future.

Commitment to Action

All participants took the **LiFE Mission pledge**, committing to environmental consciousness and sustainable practices. This pledge underscored their dedication to making efforts toward cleaner air and healthier skies.
